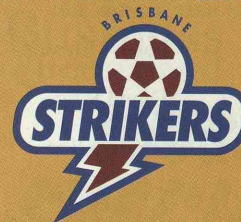

I've never been a great one for statistics probably because I'm not the sort of person to sit watching a game putting plus or minus signs against a players name - it's paperwork and I'm definitely not a paperwork person. Just ask my co-workers who constantly wonder how I can find anything on my desk. But just ask me to find something and I'll be able to get it in an instant. It's best described as "organised chaos". My filing system is in my head and that's where it's staying.

Anyway, getting back to the point, there is a place for stats in our game and there are some really basic ones that keep bobbing up. Did you know that in the majority of World Cups, European Championships and similar tournaments, that greater than 80 per cent of goals scored come from moves involving five passes or less and of goals scored from inside the box, most are first-timers or one-touch moves. It makes you wonder about the "possession game" and another simple deduction is that the scorer must be in a position to hit the target first-time ie. facing goal. This of course can be broken down even further into aspects involving the type of ball played in, the timing of the pass and the run, etc, etc. Get's complicated doesn't it!

One very important stat involving the Strikers at the moment is achieving 53 points and making the the six. At the beginning of the season I allocated one and a half points per game (34 games = 51 points) and I threw in a couple more for good measure. Our target was and still is 15 wins and eight draws (53 pts). Also you cannot lose more than a third of your matches. That's why we need to win our next four games (I'm writing this before the Wollongong game) which will give us 54 points.

You would all be aware that I have been re-appointed as coach for the next two seasons and I can tell you I couldn't be happier. Brisbane is a wonderful place to live and I truly believe the Strikers and Qld soccer have a big future. There's a very special feeling about this club and there are a lot of very special people involved with it and I'm over the moon just to be a part of it!

Also, Kossie has signed up for another two years which means the club is likely to have some stability over that period.

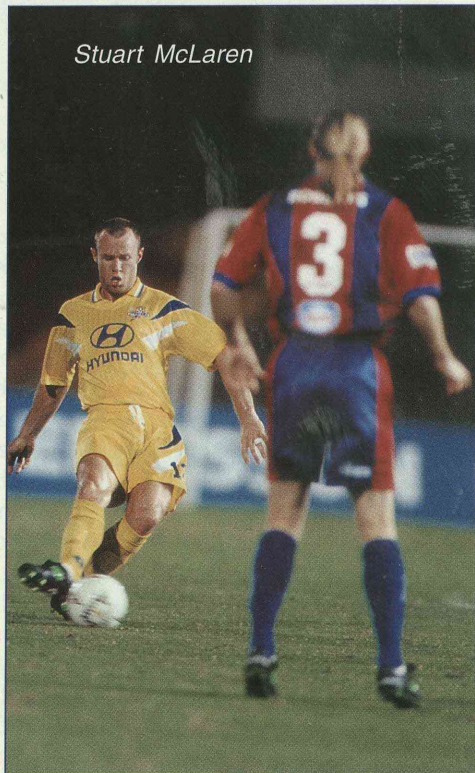
Kossie said he was extremely pleased to have reappointed as coach of the Strikers and was thrilled to maintain his association with the club.

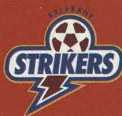

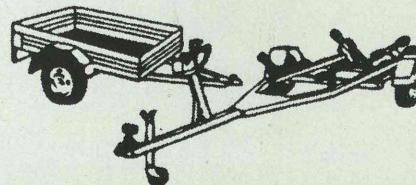

NSL Crowd Records Tumble

Two National Soccer League records have been broken over the weekend, following the completion of Round 30.

One million, two hundred and four thousand, two hundred and fifty-nine people have now passed through the turnstiles during the 99/00 season, surpassing last season's total aggregate regular season figure of 1,180,745.

With another four rounds and two catch-up games still to be played in the regular season, the 1,300,000 crowd figures is the Leagues' next target.



Round 30 also saw the goals flow with a new goals-per-game average (in a single round) record set.

A total of 40 goals were scored in the eight NSL games, an average of five goals per game, with Friday night's derby between the Carlton Soccer Club and

South Melbourne netting the highest total of eight.

The 40 goals did however fall short of the record for the most goals scored in a round, which was achieved in Round 7 of the 1985 season, when 45 goals were scored from 12 matches played.

No special case for soccer over Bosman ruling

From the Press Association, Tuesday April 18, 2000

Attempts to limit the effects of the Bosman Ruling have failed - but there could still be help for clubs battling to create effective youth schemes.

Representatives of major sporting bodies, including UEFA, met the European Commission again on Monday in the latest of a series of meetings designed to make sport a special case under the Treaty of Rome, under which employment law is enshrined.

However, despite a personal appeal from Manchester United boss Sir Alex Ferguson in Strasbourg last week, it seems that

attempts to force club sides to field a minimum number of players qualified to play for their national team are destined for the dustbin.

Christophe Forax, spokesman for European Commissioner for Culture Viviane Reding, claimed the UEFA representative stayed silent on the proposal to limit the number of 'foreign' players at yesterday's meeting and that there was no unanimity between sports for Bosman to be changed.

"There are some sports like basketball, who are quite happy with it, so we cannot change it," he said.

In their last encounter at Suncorp, the match ended in an entertaining 2-2 scorline.

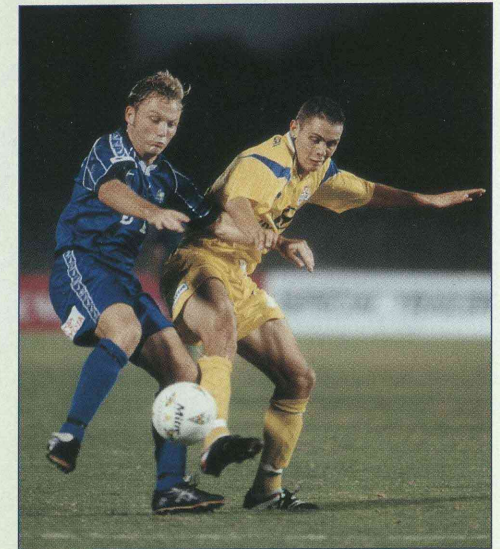
However, just a few weeks ago at North Sydney Oval, the Spirit scraped home 1-0.

Kossie and the lads will be definitely looking to reverse that result but there is no talk of revenge, rather the focus is survival.

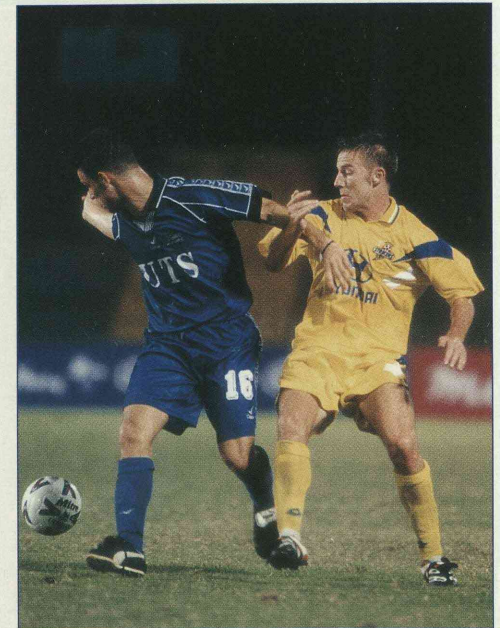
Northern Spirit have a quality outfit with players the calibre of Matthew Bingley, Tony Perinich and Robbie Slater in their line-up.

with Kossie

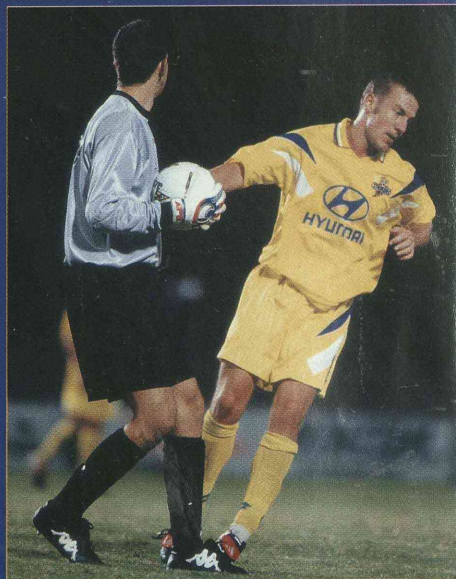
Northern Spirit have a mile of talent in their squad and are capable of beating any team in the competition on their day.

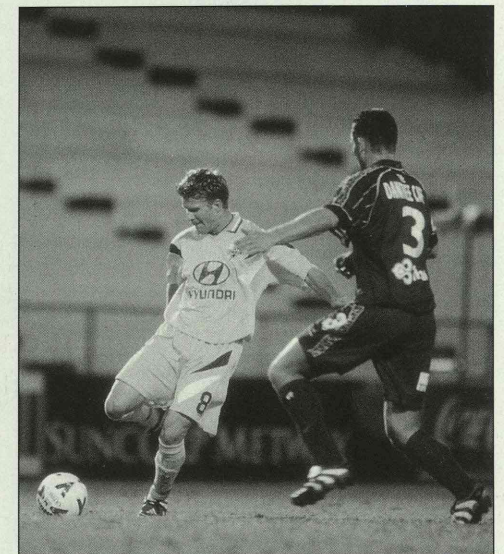

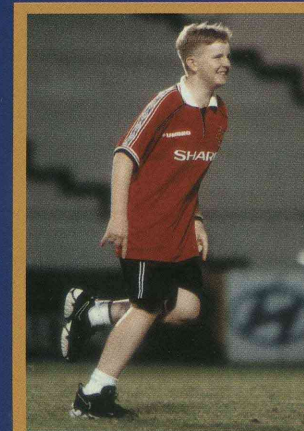
