



And there is a second prize of a huge block of Cadbury chocolate!



"They (Gippsland) took six points off us when in football terms, I firmly believe we were the better side," he said.


"They beat us in our first two encounters early in the season by the odd goal andproved extremely difficult to break down.

Talking Tagtics with Kossie


The Gippsland Falcons are an extremely difficult side to play against as they play a brand of football that can frustrate even the most patient of outfits.
